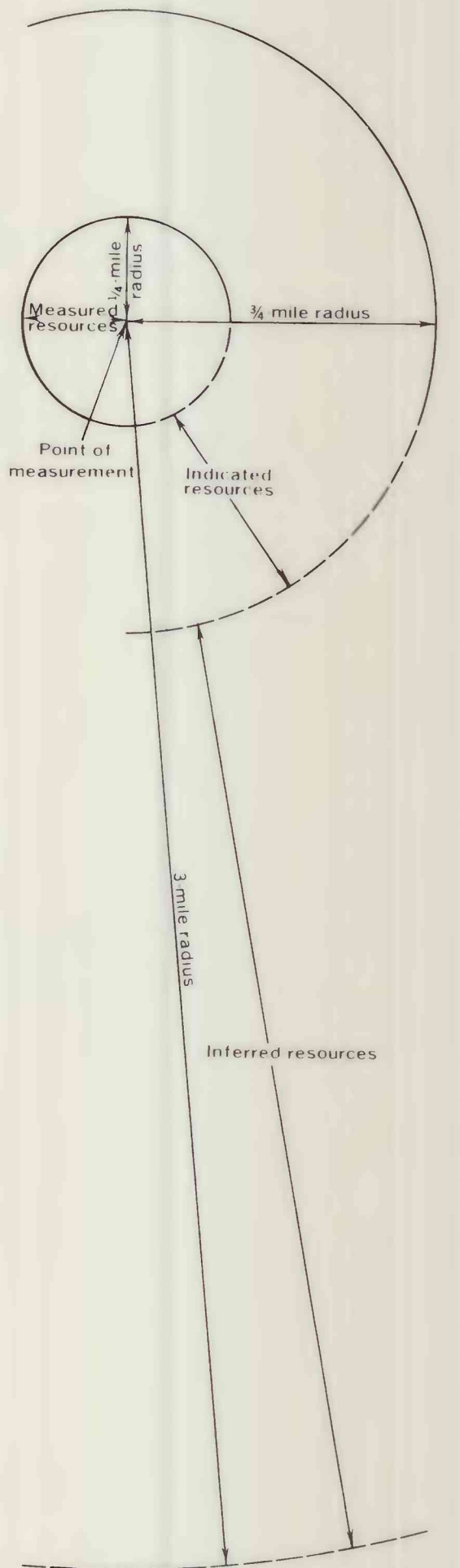

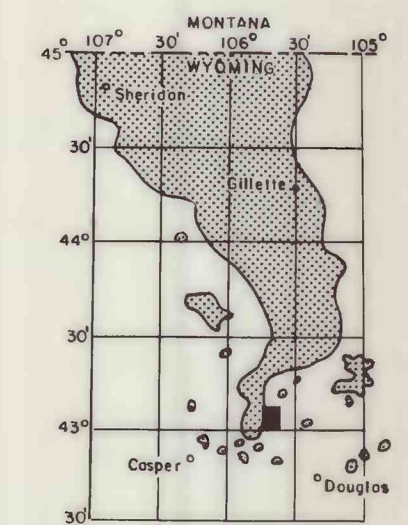


STRIPPING LIMIT LINE-500 foot
