



- EXPLANATION
-  NON-FEDERAL COAL LAND-Coal development potential is not rated.
  -  AREA OF HIGH COAL DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL FOR SURFACE MINING METHODS-Area has mining ratio values ranging from 0 to 10.
  -  AREA OF MODERATE COAL DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL FOR SURFACE MINING METHODS-Areas has mining ratio values ranging from 10 to 15.
  -  AREA OF LOW COAL DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL FOR SURFACE MINING METHODS-Area has mining ratio values greater than 15.
  -  AREA OF NO COAL DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL FOR SURFACE MINING METHODS-Area contains no known coal in beds 5 feet (1.5 m) or more thick within 500 feet (152 m) of the surface.
  -  AREA OF UNKNOWN COAL DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL FOR SURFACE MINING METHODS-Area may be underlain by coal, but where no data is available to determine a coal development potential.
