

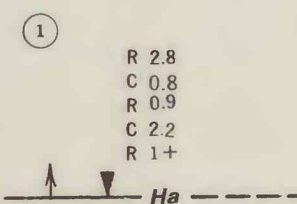

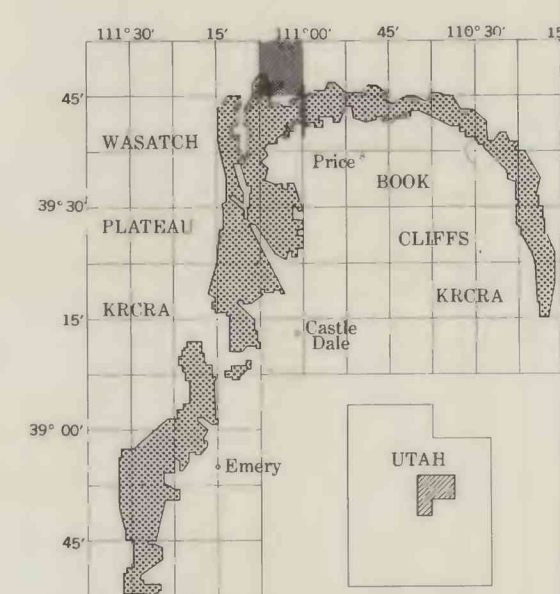
COAL BED SYMBOL AND NAME



TRACE OF COAL BED OUTCROP - Showing thickness of coal and rock, in feet, measured at triangle. Letters designate name of coal bed as listed above. Arrow points toward the coal bearing area. Index number refers to section on plate 3 of CRO map. Dashed line indicates inferred outcrop. Trace of coal outcrop modified (from Spiekler, 1931) to fit modern topographic map.
