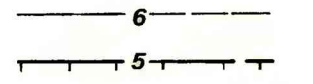


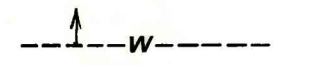

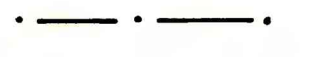

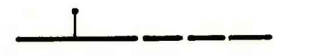
POINT OF MEASUREMENT—Showing thickness of coal, in feet.

FAULT—Dashed where approximately located; bar and ball on downthrown side.

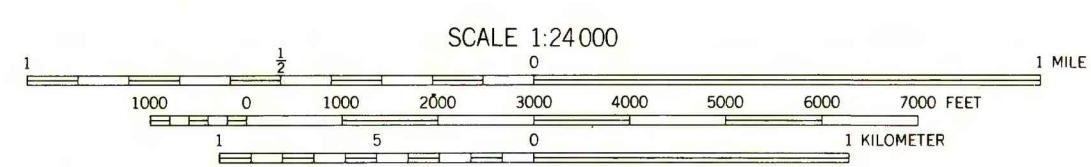
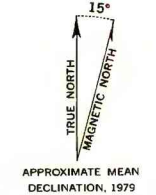


UNDERGROUND COAL MINE—Hachures point to mined-out area. Dashed where approximately located.
