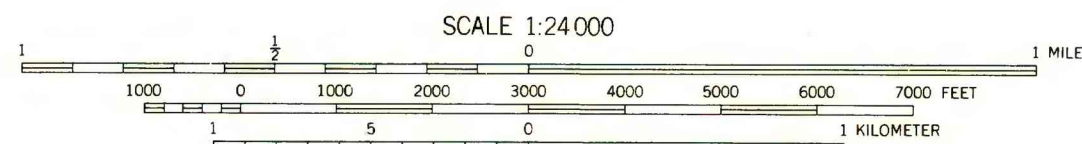
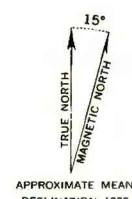
INSUFFICIENT DATA LINE—Coal thickness were not determined beyond line shown because of insufficient data.
