



EXPLANATION

-  NON-FEDERAL COAL LAND - Land for which the Federal Government does not own the coal rights, and for which the coal-development potential is not rated.
 -  AREA OF HIGH COAL DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL FOR SURFACE MINING METHODS - Includes areas underlain by coal of the Fruitland 1 bed. Area has mining ratio values ranging from 0 to 10.
 -  AREA OF MODERATE COAL DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL FOR SURFACE MINING METHODS - Includes areas underlain by coal of the Fruitland 1 bed. Area has mining ratio values ranging from 10 to 15.
 -  AREA OF LOW COAL DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL FOR SURFACE MINING METHODS - Includes areas underlain by coal of the Fruitland 1 bed. Area has mining ratio values greater than 15.
 -  AREA OF NO COAL DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL FOR SURFACE MINING METHODS - Includes areas beyond stripping limit and outside the outcrop but within KREKA.
- Unpatterned areas are FRIA and Federal coal lease lands or outside the KREKA.
