

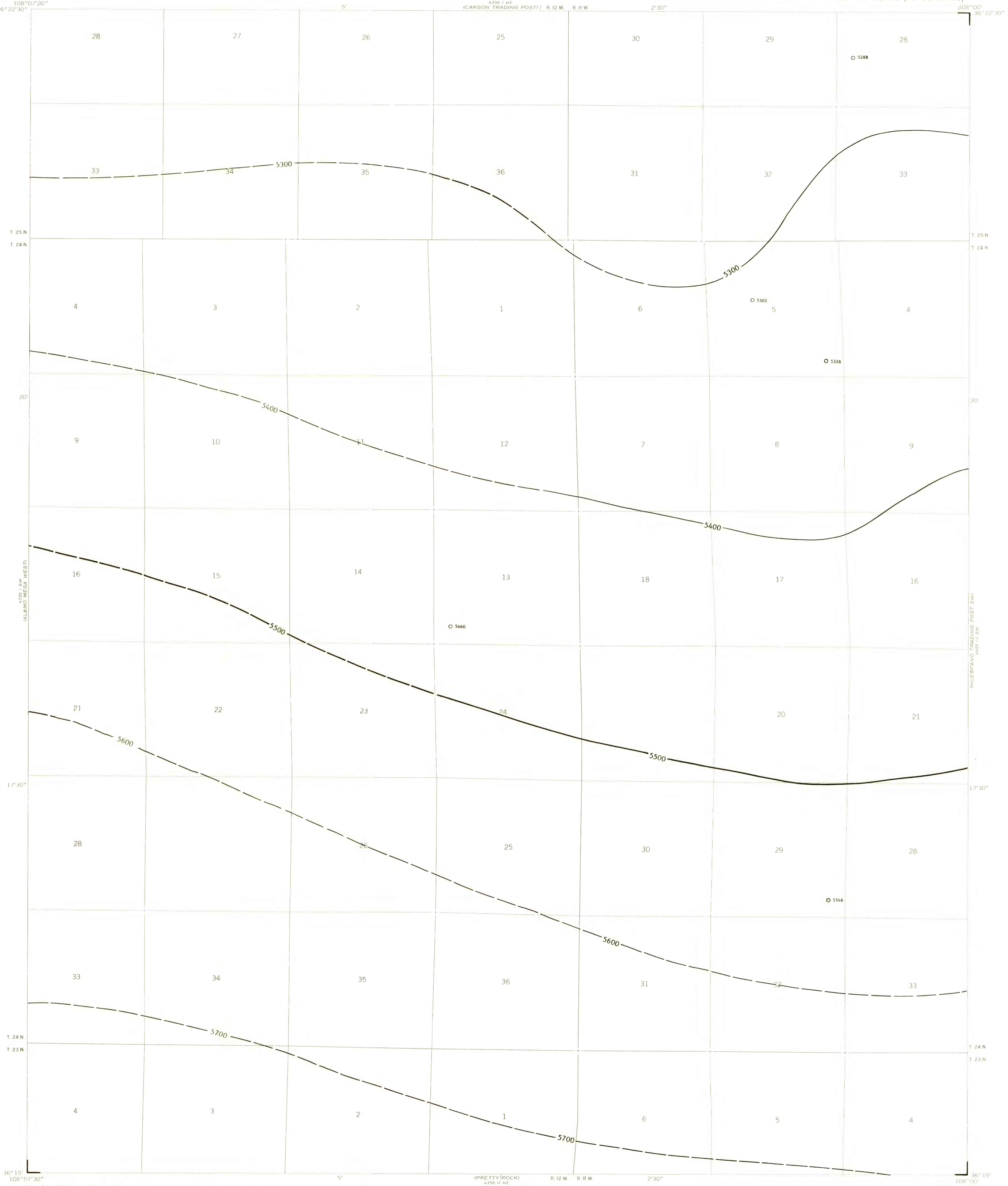

DRILL HOLE - Showing altitude at the top of the Fruitland 1 coal bed, in feet.

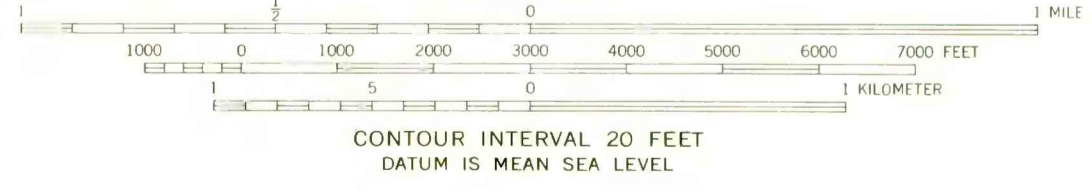
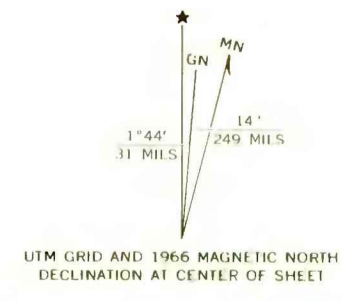
To convert feet to meters, multiply feet by 0.3048.
