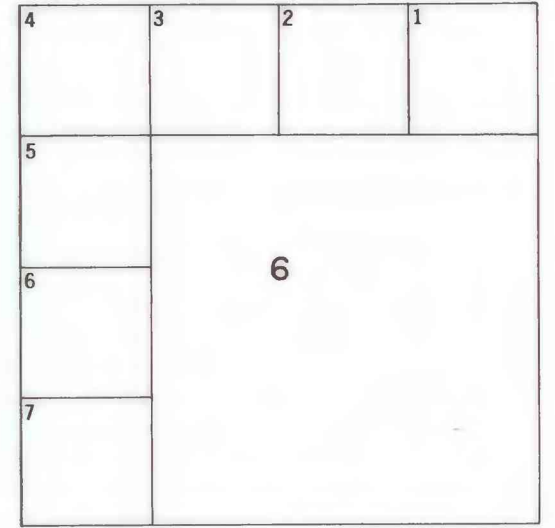


EXPLANATION

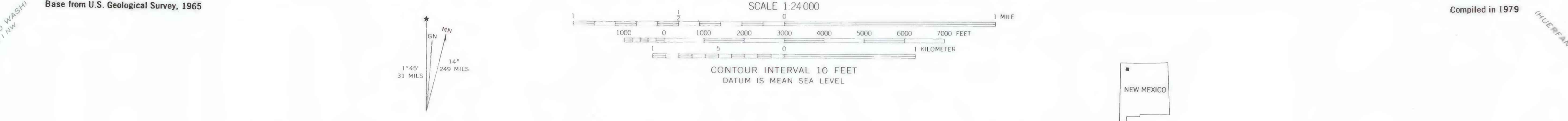


SECTION OF LAND - Showing lots and lot numbers.
