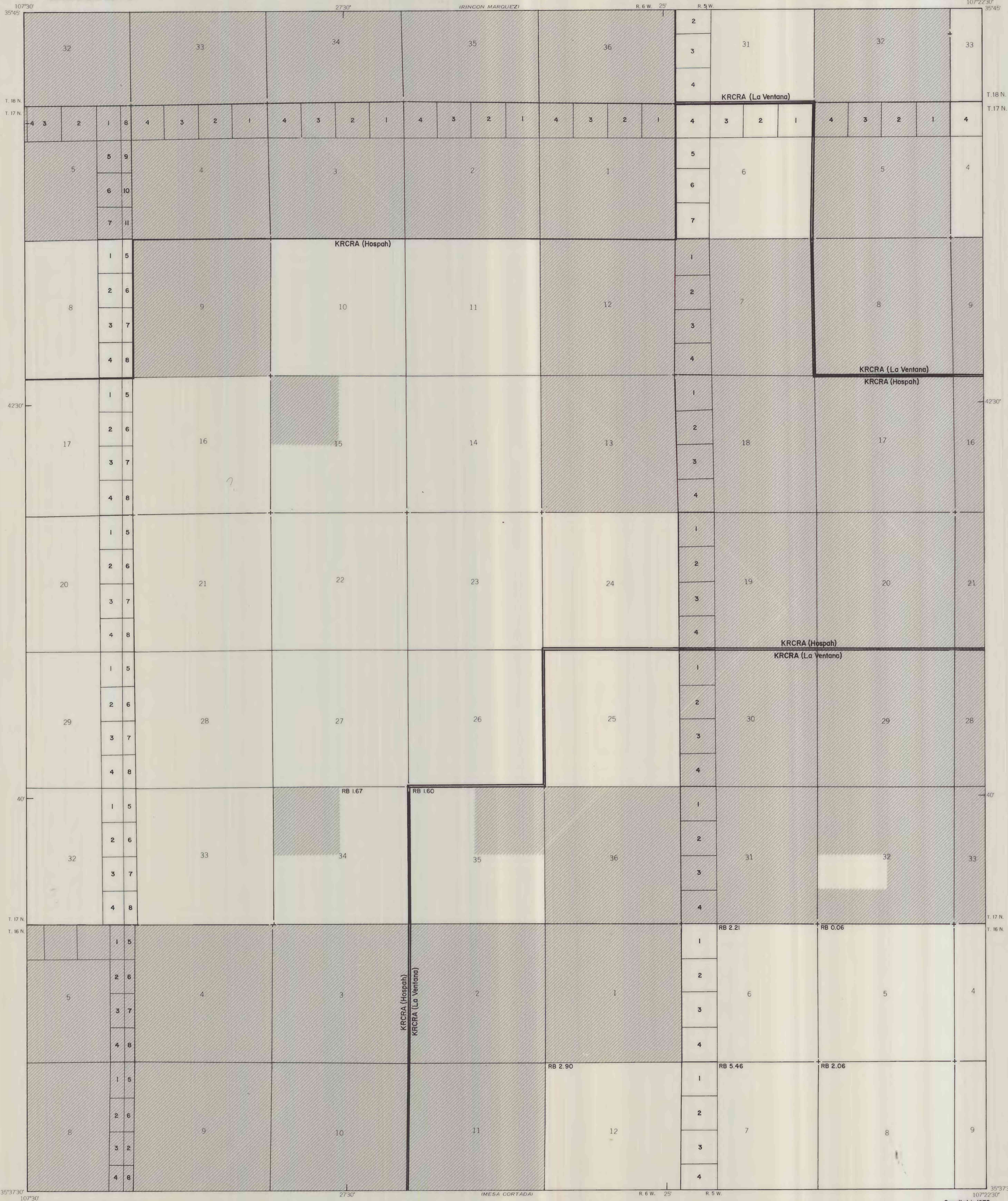

KRCRA (La Ventana)—Known Recoverable Coal Resource Area—for La Ventana area.

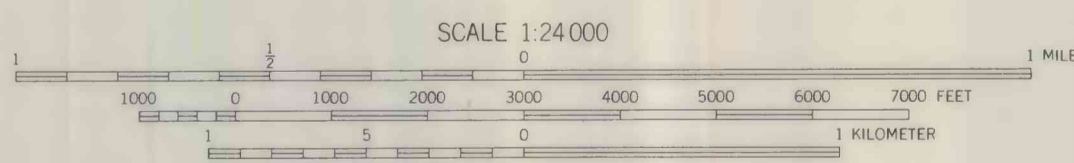
