FAULT—Dashed where approximately located; bar and bell on down-thrown side.

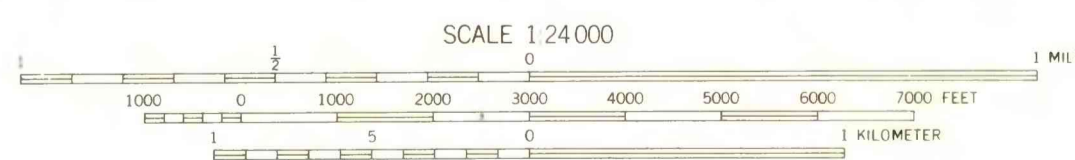
