


EXPLANATION

-  NON-FEDERAL COAL LAND—Land for which the Federal Government does not own the coal rights, and for which the coal development potential is not rated.
-  AREA OF UNKNOWN COAL DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL FOR SURFACE MINING METHODS—Includes areas within the stripping limit (200 feet-61 meters-overburden) with coal thickness less than 3.0 feet (0.9 meters), areas with insufficient data, areas outside the coal outcrop or limit of coal beds within the Cliffhouse and Menefee Formations.
-  AREA OF NO COAL DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL FOR SURFACE MINING METHODS—Includes areas outside the Cliffhouse and Menefee Formations.

To convert feet to meters, multiply feet by 0.3048.
