


EXPLANATION


DRILL HOLE - Showing thickness of coal, in feet.

TRACE OF COAL BED OUTCROP - Showing symbol of name of coal bed as listed above. Arrow points toward coal-bearing area. Short dashed where inferred by present authors.


TRACE OF FAULT - Bar and ball on down-thrown side when direction of movement is known.



COAL STRIP MINE - Hachures point toward mined area.

To convert feet to meters, multiply feet by 0.3048.

NOTE: Isopachs are not drawn beyond dotted lines because of insufficient data.
