

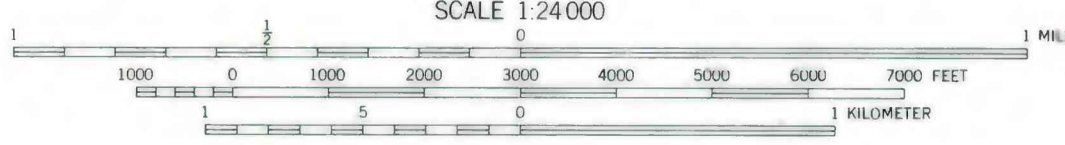
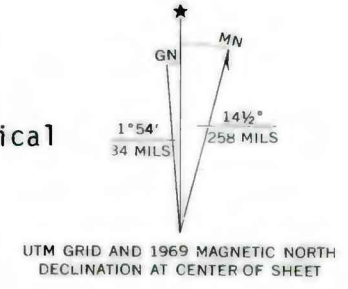

- TRACE OF FAULT - Bar and ball on down-thrown side.
- INFERRED LIMIT OF BURNED AND CLINKERED COAL - Arrow points toward area of baked and fused rock.
