

EXPLANATION

ISOPACHS - Showing thickness of coal, in feet. Isopach interval 1 foot for FU[43] and FU[19]; 5 feet for MG[10]. Datum is mean sea level.

DRILL HOLE - Showing thickness of coal, in feet.

POINT OF MEASUREMENT - Showing thickness of coal, in feet. Includes all points of measurement other than drill holes.

INTERBEDDED COAL AND ROCK - Showing total coal thickness/rock thickness.


FU[43] - Fort Union [43]
FU[19] - Fort Union [19]

COAL BED SYMBOLS AND NAMES - Coal beds or zones identified by bracketed numbers are not formally named, but are numbered for identification purposes in this quadrangle only.

TRACE OF COAL BED OUTCROP - Showing symbol of name of coal bed or zone as listed above. Arrow points toward coal-bearing area. Short dashed where projected by present authors.

TRACE OF FAULT - Bar and ball on down-thrown side. Dashed where inferred.

To convert feet to meters, multiply feet by 0.3048.



