


STRUCTURE CONTOURS—Drawn on top of coal bed, in feet. Solid where vertical accuracy within 40 feet; long dashed where vertical accuracy possibly not within 40 feet; short dashed where projected above land surface. Contour interval is 80 feet (24.4 m). Datum is mean sea level.

POINT OF MEASUREMENT—Showing altitude of top of coal bed, in feet.





FAULT—Dashed where approximately located; bar and ball on downthrown side; Dotted where concealed.
