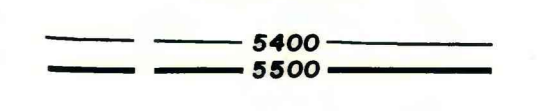

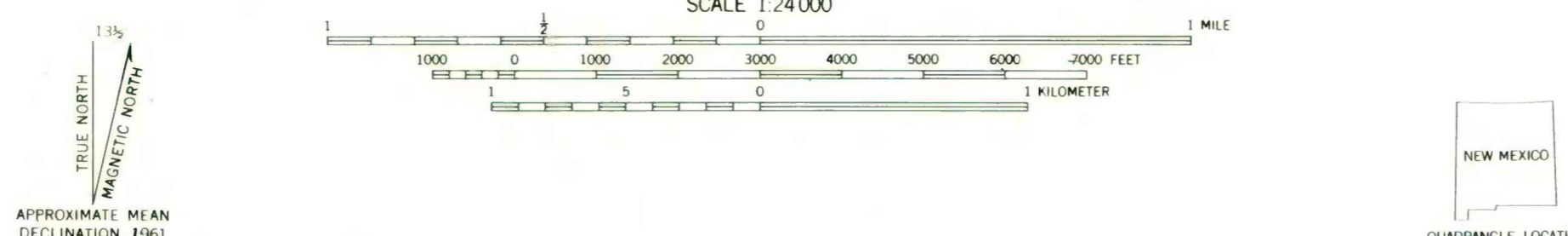
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DRILL HOLE—Showing altitude at top of the Menefee Cleary coal zone in feet.
