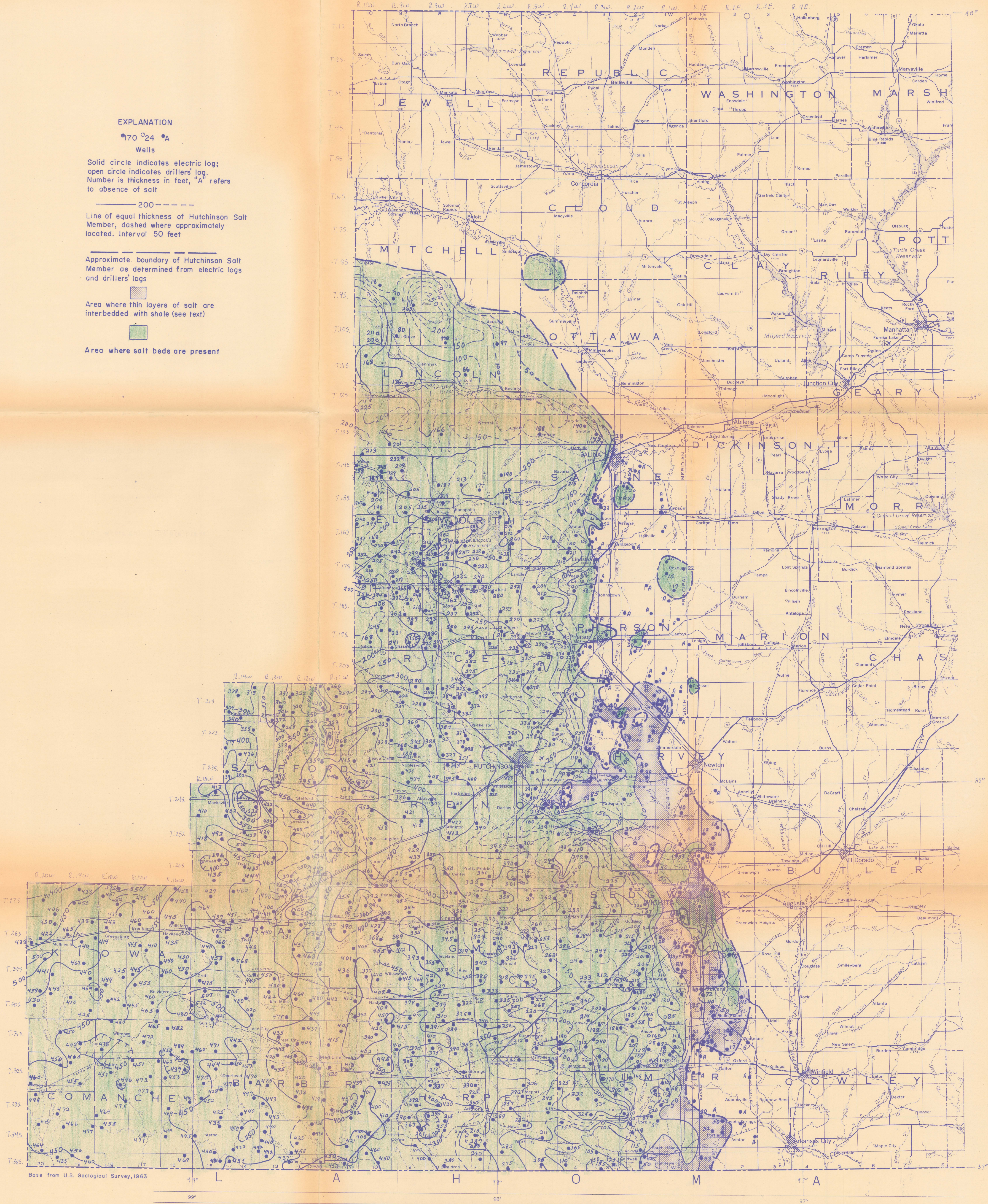
Approximate boundary of Hutchinson Salt

interbedded with shale (see text)

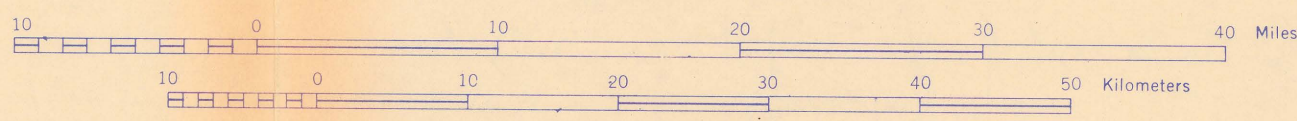


Area where salt beds are present
