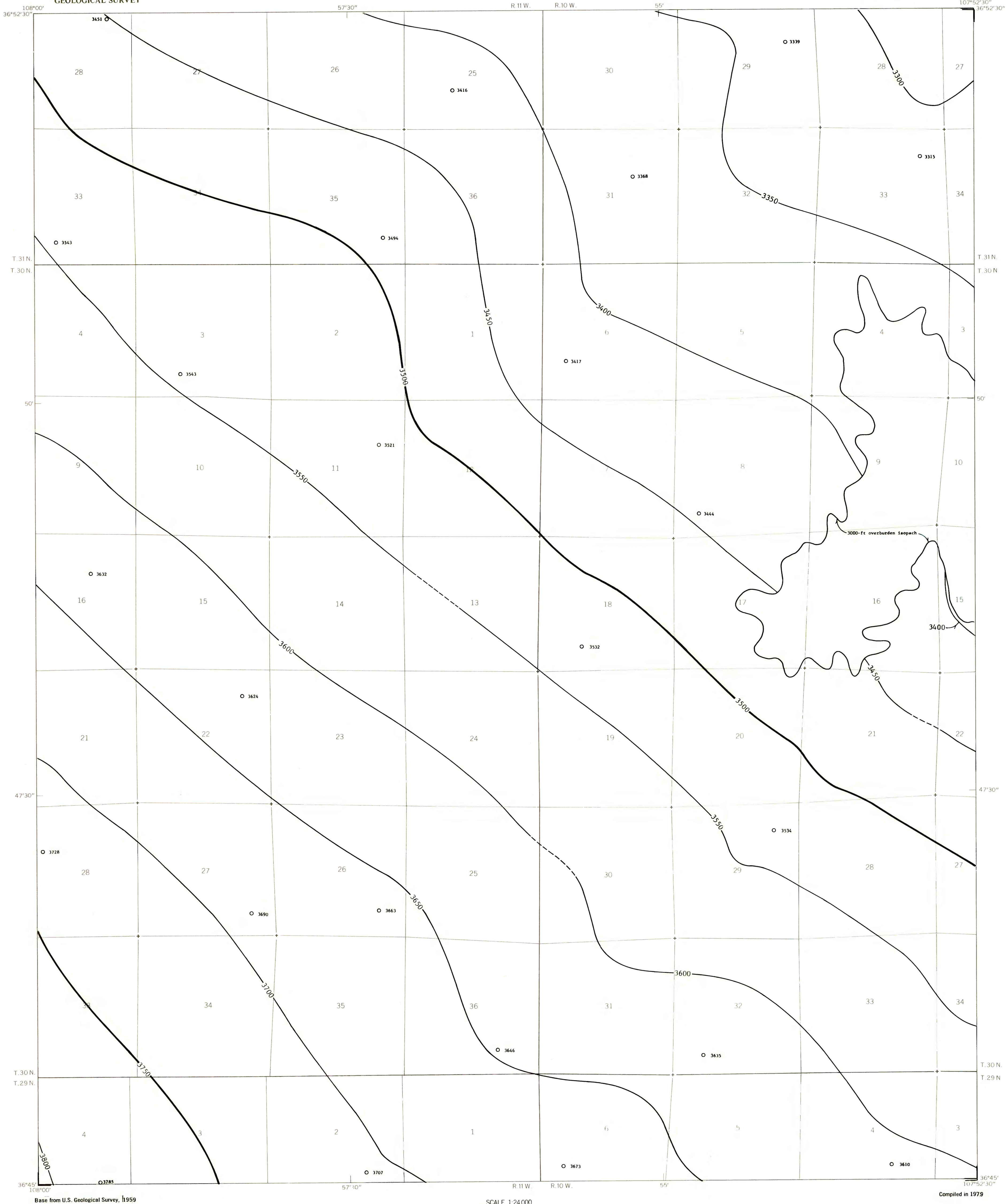

STRUCTURE CONTOURS - Drawn on top of the Fruitland 1 coal bed. Contour interval 50 feet (15.2 meters). Datum is mean sea level. Contours dashed where projected through noncoal-bearing area.

DRILL HOLES - Showing altitude at the top of the Fruitland 1 coal bed, in feet.

To convert feet to meters, multiply feet by 0.3048.

Fruitland coal beds contoured as a single surface on this map are equivalent in stratigraphic position but may not be continuous.
