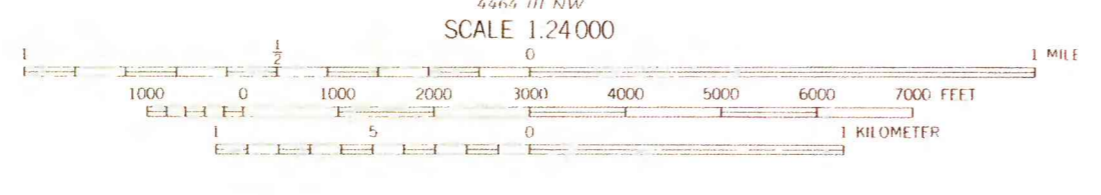
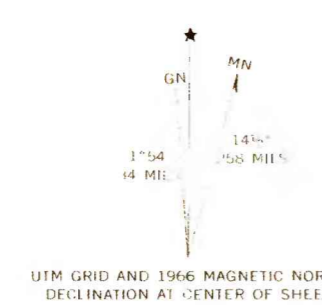
INTERBEDDED COAL AND ROCK - Showing total coal thickness/rock thickness.
