

- NON-FEDERAL COAL LAND - Land for which the Federal Government does not own the coal rights, and for which the Coal-Development Potential is not rated.

AREA OF COAL LEASE ON FEDERAL LAND - Showing coal lease number.
- Coal Lse. U098705
AREA OF HIGH COAL-DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL - Area contains coal in beds 5 feet (1.5 m) or more thick between the coal outcrop a depth of 1,000 feet (304.8 m).
- AREA OF MODERATE COAL-DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL - Area contains coal in beds 5 feet (1.5 m) or more thick at depths ranging from 1,000 to 2,000 feet (304.8 to 609.6 m).
- AREA OF UNKNOWN COAL-DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL - Area contains insufficient information to determine either the thickness, the depth or the presence of coal beds 5 feet (1.5 m) or more thick.
- AREA OF NO COAL-DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL - No coal beds are present in area; or coal beds are present at depths greater than 3,000 feet (914.4 m).
