DRILL HOLE—Showing thickness of the Crevasse Canyon Gibson No. 6 coal bed in feet.

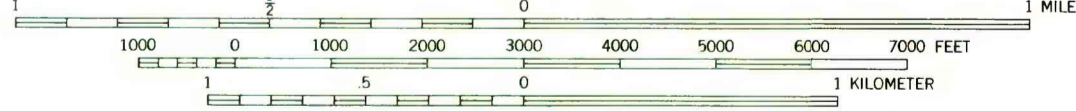
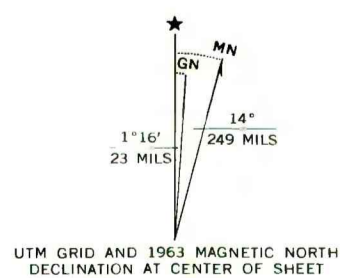
