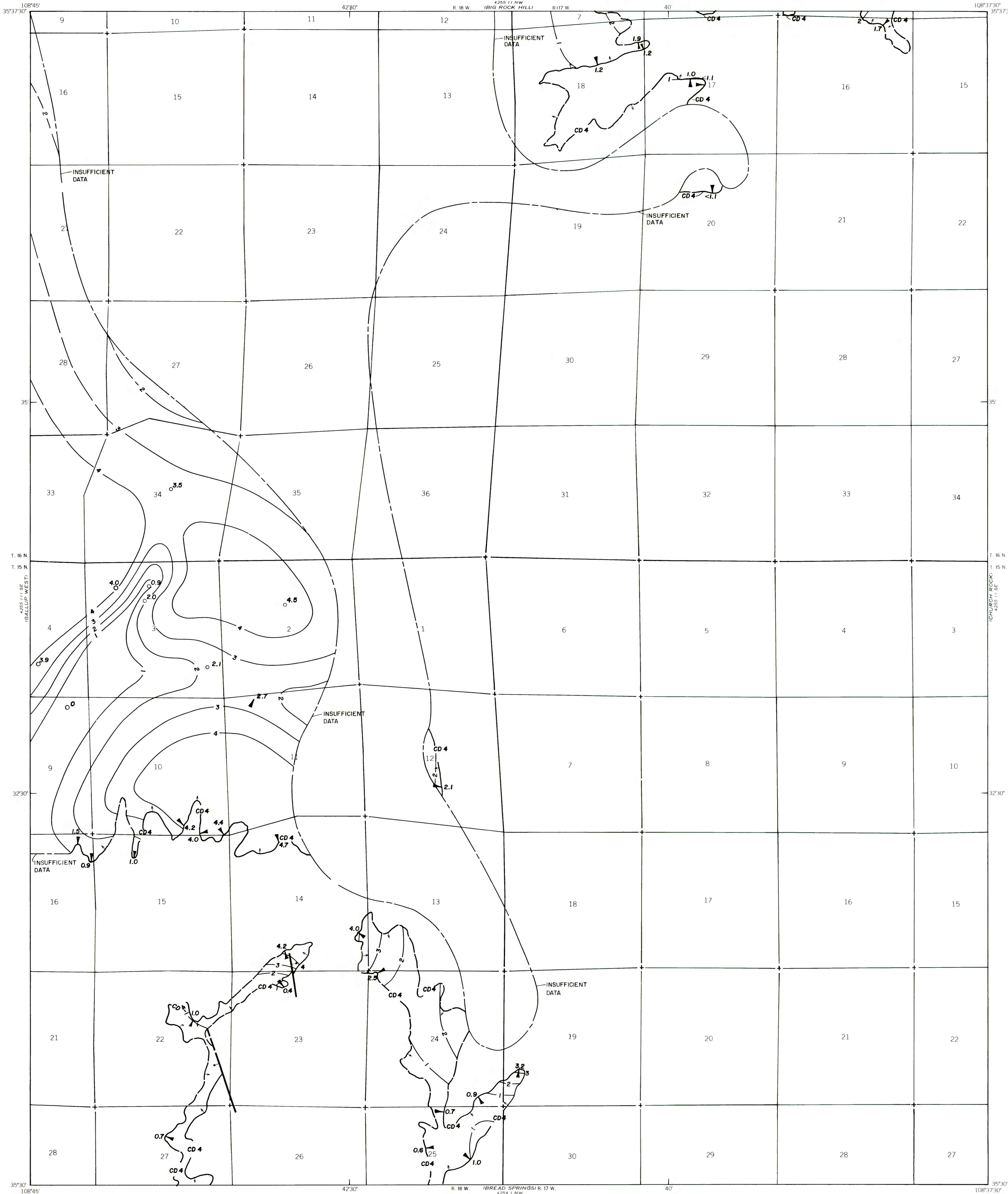

**DRILL HOLE**-Showing thickness of the Crevasse Canyon Dilco No. 4 coal bed in feet.

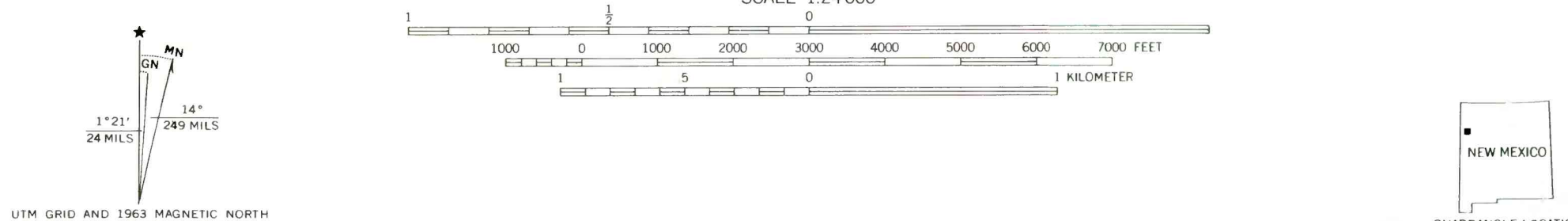
