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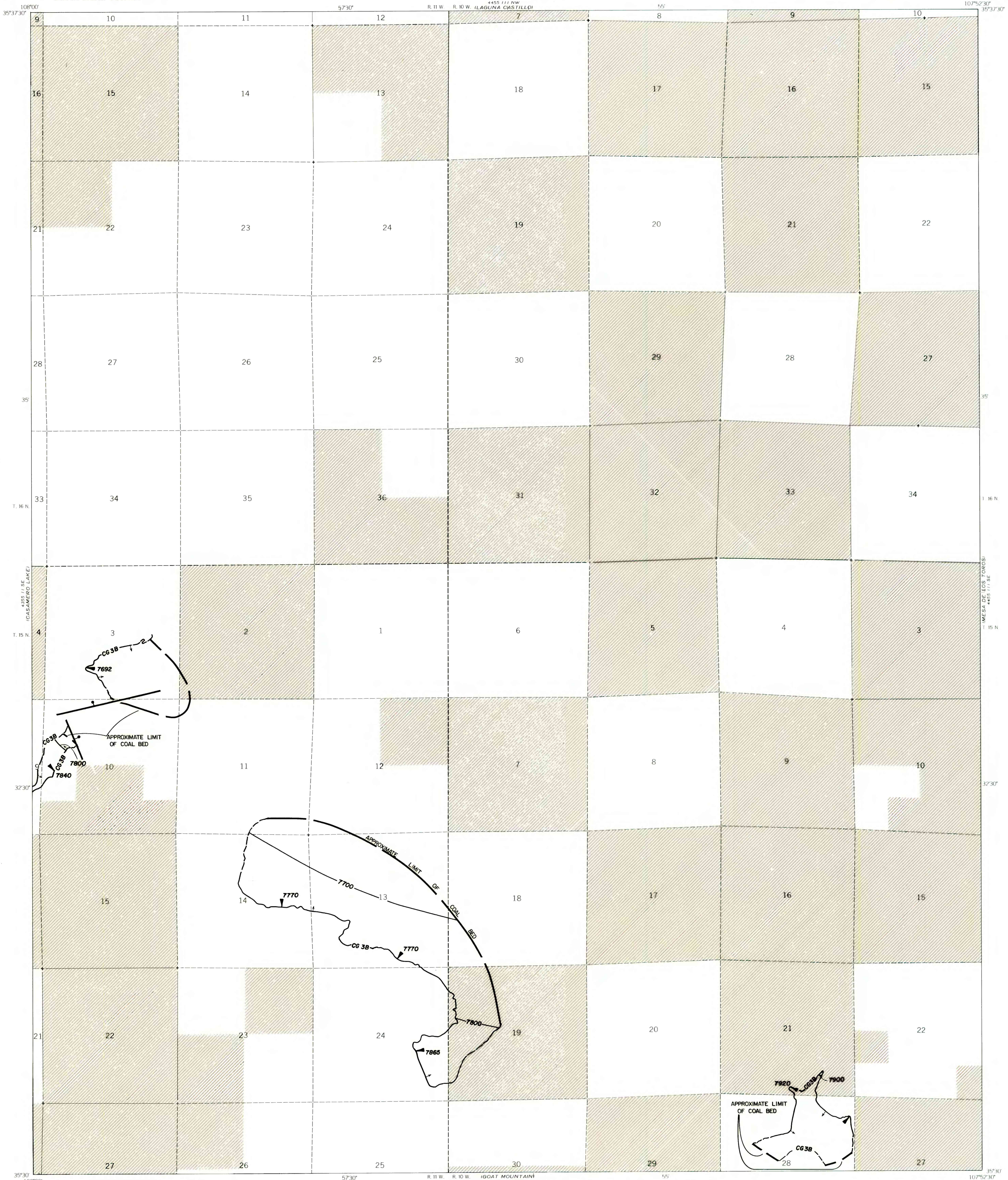

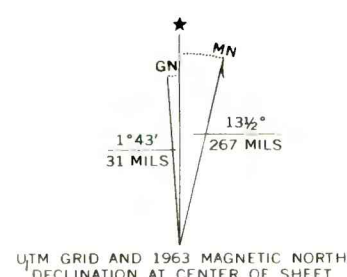
**FAULT**—Bar and bell on the down-thrown side.
