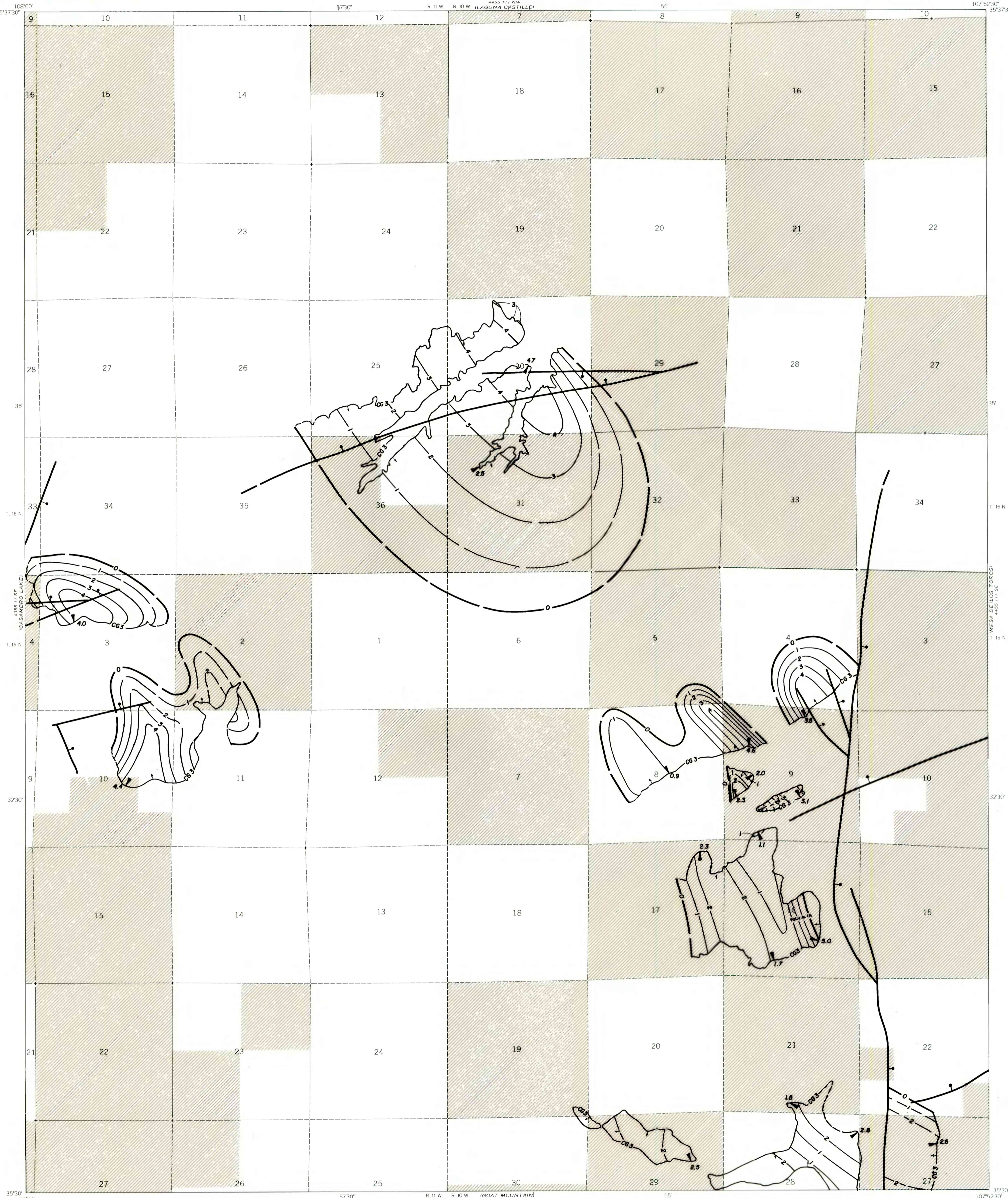

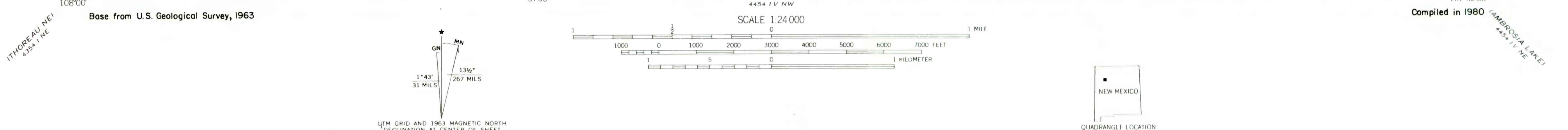
EXPLANATION

ISOPACHS OF THE CREVASSE CANYON GIBSON NO. 3 COAL BED—Showing thickness in feet. Isopach interval 1 foot (0.3 meter). Isopachs dashed where inferred.

TRACE OF COAL BED OUTCROP—Showing coal thickness, in feet, measured at triangle. Arrow points toward the coal-bearing area. Dashed line indicated inferred outcrop.

FAULT—Dashed where approximately located; bar and bell on down-thrown side.

To convert feet to meters, multiply feet by 0.3048.
