Trace of coal zone contact dotted where concealed by alluvium.

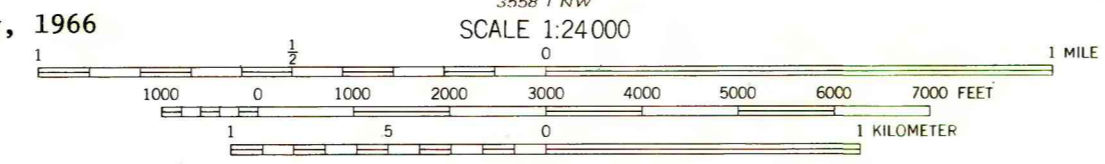
COAL ZONE SYMBOL AND NAME - Symbol appears as an identifier with the map symbols indicated above.
