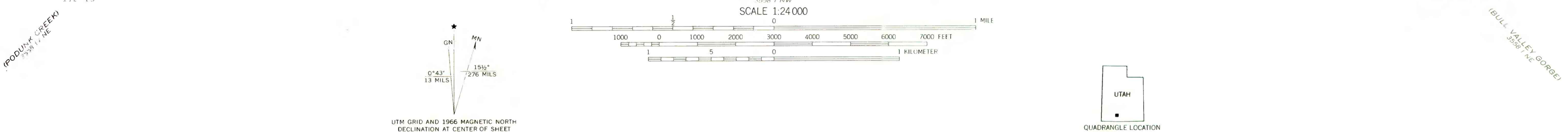


- KRCRA**
KRCRA BOUNDARY - Label within KRCRA boundary.
- NON-FEDERAL COAL LAND - Land for which the Federal Government does not own the coal rights, and for which the Coal-Development Potential is not rated.
- AREA OF HIGH COAL-DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL - Area contains coal in beds 5 feet (1.5 m) or more thick between the coal outcrop and the 10 Mining Ratio contour.
- AREA OF MODERATE COAL-DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL - Area contains coal in beds 5 feet (1.5 m) or more thick between the 10 and 15 Mining Ratio contours.
- AREA OF LOW COAL-DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL - Area contains coal in beds 5 feet (1.5 m) or more thick between the 15 Mining Ratio contour and the Stripping Limit.
- AREA OF UNKNOWN COAL-DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL - Area contains insufficient information to determine either the thickness, the depth or the presence of coal beds 5 feet (1.5 m) or more thick.
- AREA OF NO COAL-DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL - Area contains coal beds less than 5 feet (1.5 m) thick, or coal is over 5 feet (61 m) thick but under more than 200 feet (61 m) of overburden.
