


- EXPLANATION**
-  NON-FEDERAL COAL LAND - Land for which the Federal Government does not own the coal rights, and for which the coal-development potential is not rated.
  -  AREA OF HIGH COAL-DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL - Area has mining-ratio values ranging from 0 to 10.
  -  AREA OF LOW COAL-DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL - Area has mining-ratio values greater than 15.
  -  AREA OF UNKNOWN COAL-DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL - Area contains no known coal in beds 5 feet (1.5 m) or more thick within 100 feet (31 m) of the surface, but coal-bearing units are present in the area.
