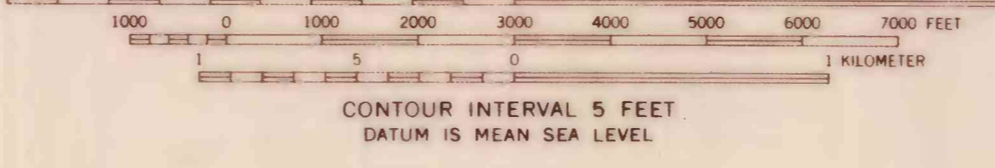
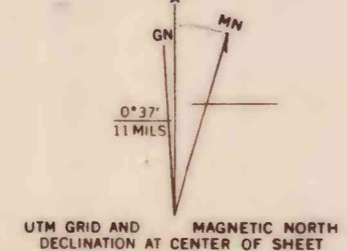

The date of the depth to water level observation is included where available. Springs and depth to water for observations without known dates are included even though the data are not as useful. The user should be aware that the presence of springs and depth to water may change with the time of year, and with the amount of water withdrawn from nearby wells. All observations reported herein were between 1963 and 1979, and most were between April and June and between September and December.
