

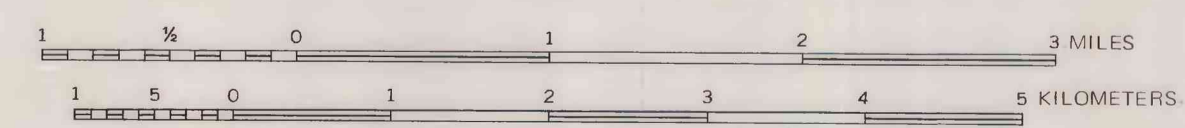
EXPLANATION

NOTE: Some wells plot in sections differing from that indicated by the State well number designation. This occurs because State well numbers, once assigned to a well, remain unchanged even if more detailed maps later show that the well is in a different location with respect to section lines from the original location used to assign the well number.
