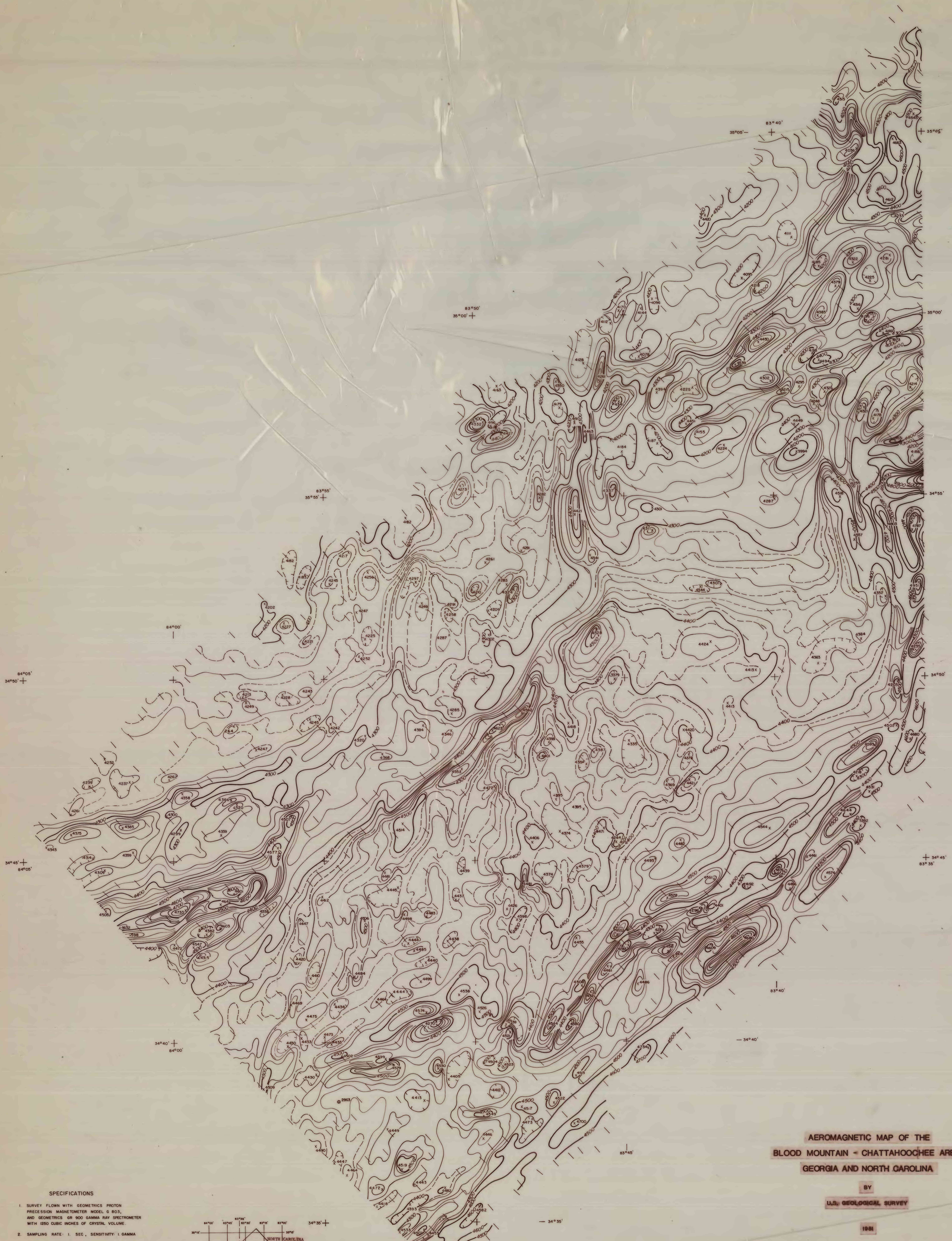

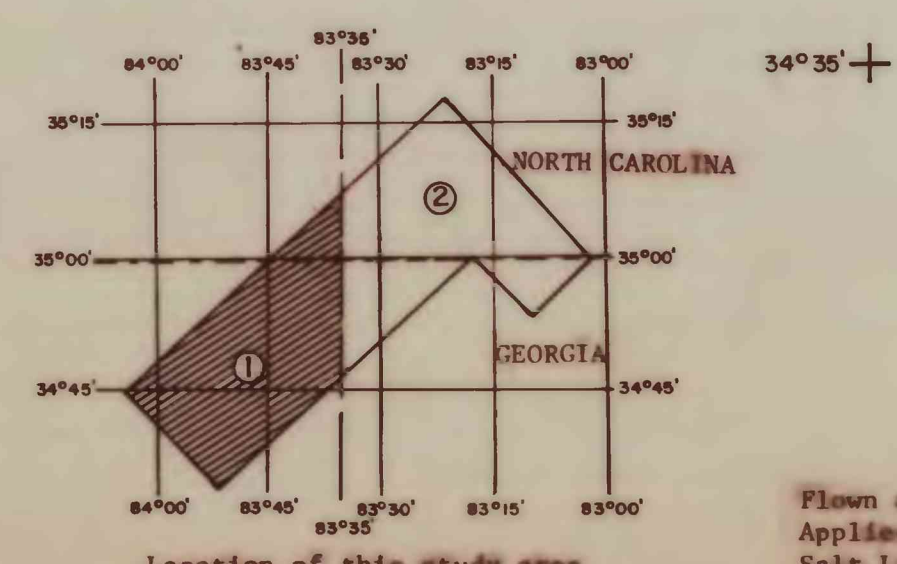
AEROMAGNETIC MAP OF THE
