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DISCUSSION

This open-file report consists of three colored 35-mm photographic slides that show geology, mineralized areas, and areas that contain rocks and structures that are favorable for the occurrence of metallic mineral resources in the eastern Pioneer Mountains, Beaverhead County, Mont.

Slide 1.--Geologic map of the eastern Pioneer Mountains, Mont.

Slide 2.--Mineral resources, eastern Pioneer Mountains, Mont.
