

FRONTISPIECE — A seven-image mosaic of the Potomac River just below the Woodrow Wilson Bridge, south of Washington, D.C. The photographs were obtained by the Army Corps of Engineers on September 12, 1985, as part of their study of the river. The camera used was a Wild RC10 loaded with Eastman Aerochrome exposed at a height of 6,000 feet.

North is to the top in this image and the Woodrow Wilson Bridge is at the top of the page. The mosaic (1:24,000
