

EXPLANATION MAP D

All contacts are inferred except at profile crossings.

- Scarp, hachures on down side
- Fault, ball on down side; queried where doubtful; strike inferred; exclusive of lower-slope unit
- Upslope (detachment) side of mass movement
- Slide or slump toe
- Rubble along profile; pattern shows inferred areal extent
- Fracture; strike inferred; exclusive of lower-slope unit
- Small channel
- Approximate margin of eroded upper-slope
- Filled channel in foreset unit
- Inner edge of shelf facet
- Approximate updip margin of layered rise unit
- Buried anticline
- Buried syncline
- Crest of surficial layer
- Ramp foot; toe of surficial layer
- Bench below which upper-slope unit is exposed
- Bench marks top (?) of rugged lower slope, inferred outcrop of lower-slope unit
- Marks culmination, cuesta or inflection at or near updip end of layered rise unit
- Contact between foreset unit and rugged, eroded downslope bench
- Trackline, Iselin (I) 7-78-2 (1978)
- Trackline, Gilliss (G) 7903-03 (1979).
- Cross-tics indicate hour intervals (numbers keyed to seismic profiles). Large numbers indicate beginnings or ends of numbered profiles.
