DESCRIPTION

FASTMAP is a geologic map drafting program for the Apple Macintosh Computer. FASTMAP runs on any model Macintosh provided it has at least one Megabyte of RAM. A hard disk is not required but greatly speeds editing. A detailed user's manual for FASTMAP is being compiled. This open-file report consists of a computer disk with the source code, the compiled code, a preliminary manual in a TEXT file, the SendPS utility (courtesy of Adobe Systems Inc.) and a TEXT file version of this report. Although this program has been extensively tested, the U.S. Geological Survey cannot guarantee that it will give accurate results for all applications, or that it will work on all computer systems.
