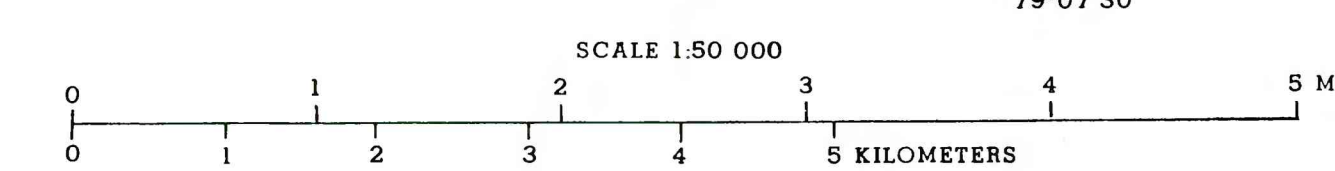
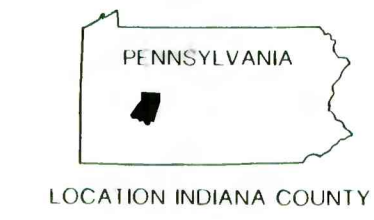


Plate 2—Locations of wells, springs, surface-water sites, and precipitation sites, southern Indiana County, Pennsylvania.
