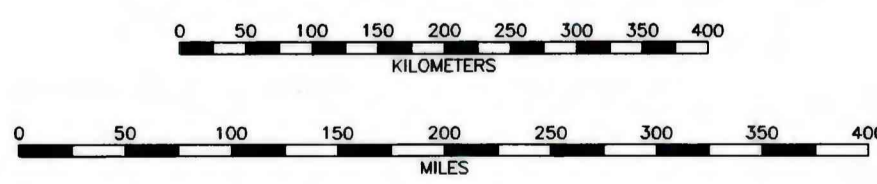


LEGEND

EXPLANATION

The 573 wells plotted produced gas or oil during an initial potential test or had a producing formation whose top was at a depth greater than 14,800 feet. A few of the wells may be producing from undifferentiated Cretaceous-Tertiary rocks. The well data was derived from Petroleum Information's Well History Control System files current to approximately June 1991.
