


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Horizontal Gradient Magnitude of Pseudogravity

Color shaded-relief image of horizontal gradient magnitude of pseudogravity (vertical integral of the continued, reduced-to-pole magnetic data). Prominent ridges on this map locate steep gradients, which are commonly associated with lithologic contacts or faults. Illumination is from the west. Color intervals follow a histogram-equalization stretch.
