

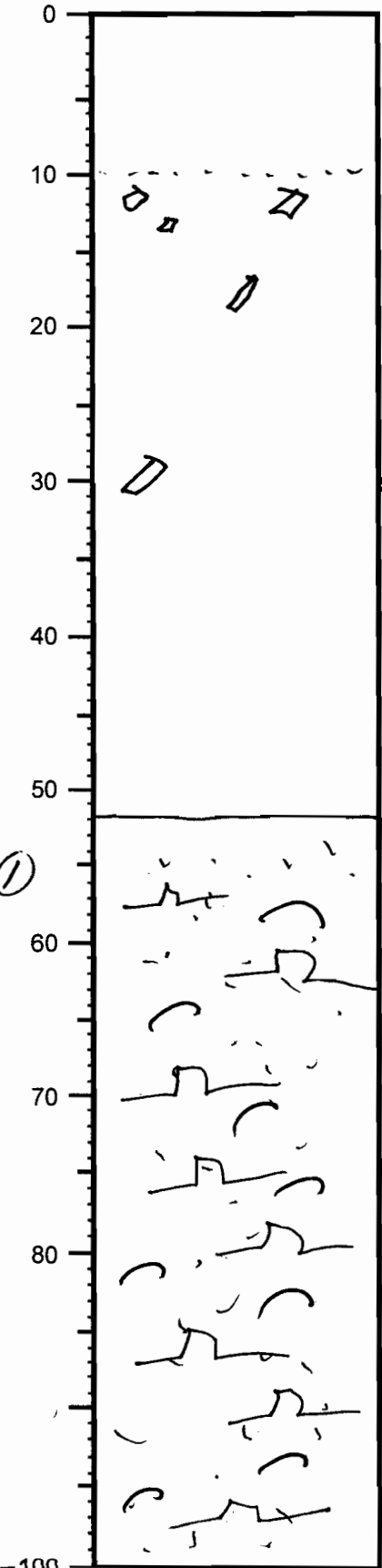

Some whole shells.

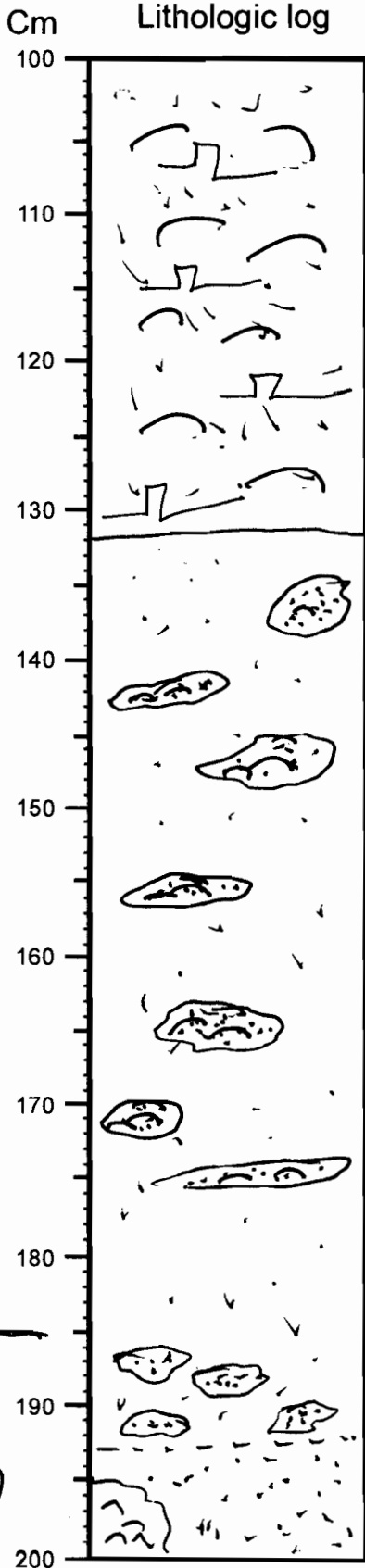

Grayish green silty fine sand that is heavily burrowed at the top & less so at base. Burrows filled with coarse sand and shell hash

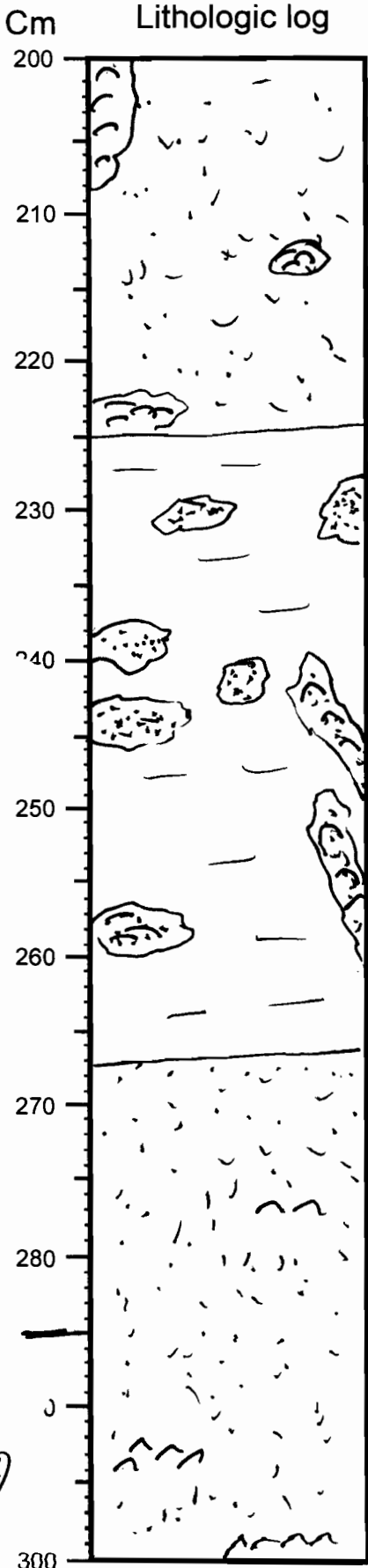
Gradational contact due to heavy burrowing. Coarse grayish green sand

Grayish green coarse sand with some burrows filled with shell hash

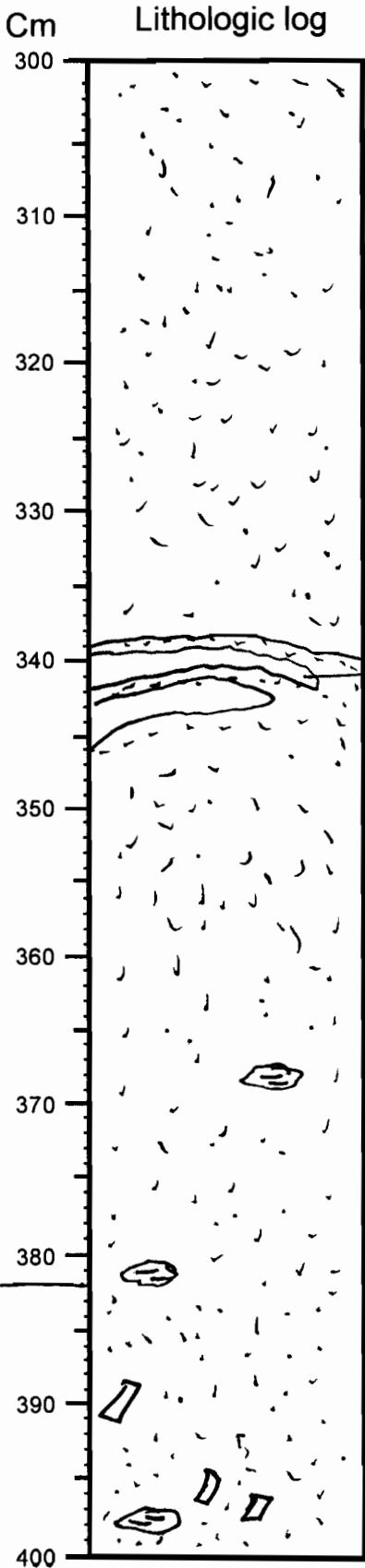
Heavily burrowed grayish green silty clay - burrows filled with coarse sand & shell hash

Quartz sand - few/no heavies

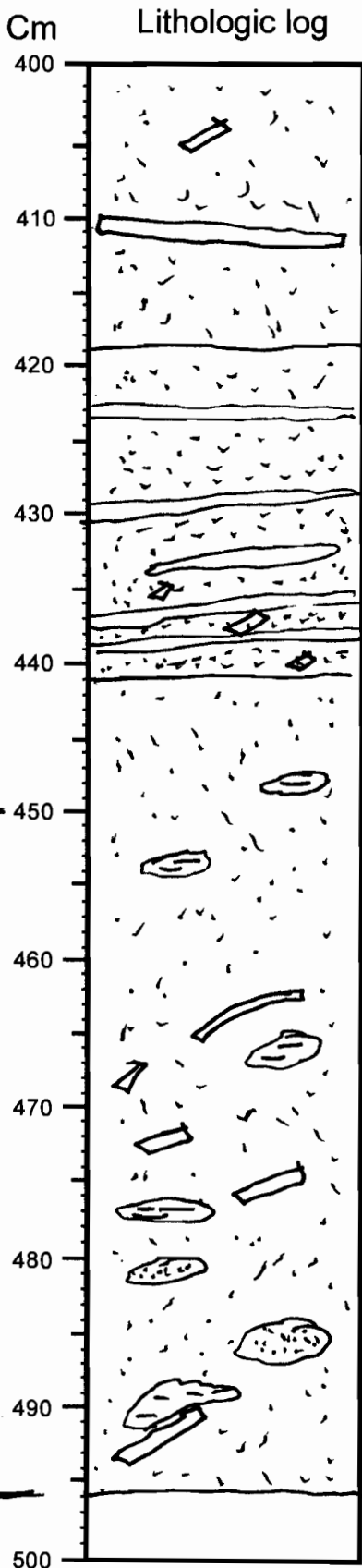
Light olive gray clay clasts / beds(?)

at base + some silt filled burrows.
Quartz sand few/no heavies

Light olive green coarse sand

~~Dark~~ Dusk green coarse sand interbedded with silt laminae - Abundant small wood fragments. No shell hash

Light green medium-coarse sand with some clasts (burrans?) filled with silt or light brown sand. Some wood fragments
