

AB3143 – Southern part of Jordan Side Valleys, on east edge of Jordan Valley

Well AB3143 “KAFRAIN MONITORING 2” is a monitoring well on the edge of the Jordan Valley where the aquifer saturated thickness has declined substantially. The current rate of decline is about -0.65 m/yr, which is less than the long-term average rate of -2.7 m/yr since 2000. The saturated thickness of the Alluvial aquifer at this well is forecast in 2030 to be about 46 percent of the saturated thickness in 2000.
