



EXPLANATION

Photomosaics and line work for the cuts 13, 11, 8, and 7 of trench 1. All photomosaics shown with view orthogonal to sloping, nonvertical wall; sloping walls produce approximately 20 percent vertical exaggeration. Grid provides scale for each wall in meters; horizontal scale is consistent for all exposures; vertical scale is variable.

— Contact—Key horizons are shown with consistent colors; other units shown in thin black or gray; dashed where contact is diffuse or gradational

— Fault—Solid where location is certain, dashed where location is approximate
