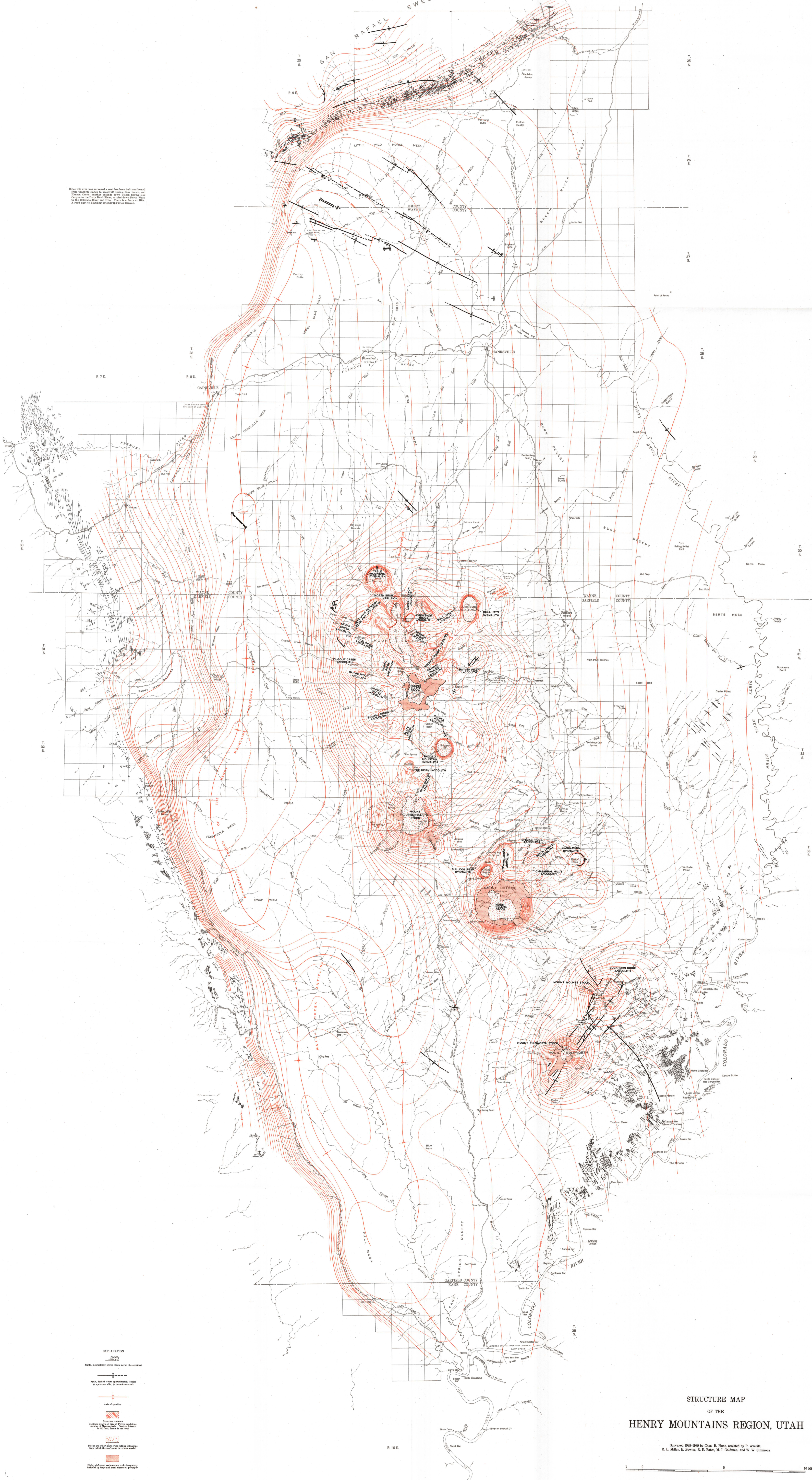


Since this area was surveyed a road has been built northwest from Thacker Ranch to Blackfoot Spring. Bear River and Flaming Creek, neither outside area. Point Spring and Canyon in the upper right corner. A good view north from the Colorado River at 2000. There is a lake at 2000. A road west to Standing outside of Parley Canyon.
