


EXPLANATION

Upland surfaces

Undulating and gently sloping areas on ridge tops, most slopes range from about 2° to 6°; areas very irregular in outline, long and narrow, length of many surfaces ranges from 6 to 10 miles. Extent of upland surfaces is determined in part by location of restored contours and does not include all undulating to gently sloping areas on ridge tops
