




CORRELATION OF MAP UNITS



DESCRIPTION OF MAP UNITS

- FEBRUARY 1969** LAVA FLOWS OF FEBRUARY 22-28, 1969 - Includes small volume of spatter and pumice. Line denotes vent fissures
 - OCTOBER 1968** LAVA FLOWS OF OCTOBER 7-22, 1968 - Includes small volume of spatter and pumice. Line denotes vent fissures; dotted line where concealed by younger lava
 - AUGUST 1968** LAVA FLOWS OF AUGUST 22-26, 1968 - Includes small volume of spatter and pumice. Line denotes vent fissures
 - Pre-1968** LAVA ERUPTED BEFORE 1968 - Includes historic and prehistoric flows, cones, and fissures, many of which are shown on map by Moore and Koyanagi (1969, pl. 2)
- Contact - Dotted where concealed by younger lava
 — Graben reactivated in October 1968

Note: Much of the February 1969 lava between Aloi and Napau Craters has been covered by flows erupted in 1969-72. Some of the October 1968 and February 1969 lava north and east of Puu Kamoamoas is covered by flows erupted on August 4-11, 1969. Contacts shown in these areas are approximate, because aerial photographs used in the mapping were not taken until late 1972 and early 1973.
