DESCRIPTION Proceed 11.0 mi southeast along the East Entrance highway from its junction with the Canyon-Lake highway (just west of Fishing Bridge). Bench mark is about 55 ft south of the centerline of the highway, about 20 ft below the highway, set in a concrete monument, and marked by a metal fence post 1.3 ft to the north. From the mark it is 159ft at N8W to a 10" fir across the road and 90 ft at N40E to a 15" fir on the same side of the road.

In 2008 the bench mark was searched for and not found, presumed destroyed. The FHWA description places the bench mark at the location of large, new pullout. Trees referenced in FHWA description are not found and were likely removed. The bench mark was probably destroyed by road work.
