**DESCRIPTION** Proceed 10.1 km (6.30 mi) south along the Madison-West Thumb highway from Madison Junction, thence 3.5 km (2.15 mi) east along a service road and Mary Mountain Trail to a foot bridge across Nez Perce Creek. Bench mark is a disk crimped to the top of a steel rod (driven to refusal at 12 feet) and encased in a 6-inch PVC pipe, 9.4 m (30.8 ft) east of the south end of the bridge, 4.3 m (14.1 ft) south of the south bank of the creek, between the third and fourth (3-foot high) wooden posts at end of the service road, and about level with the road and trail.
