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### DATE OF DESCRIPTION 2002

**DESCRIPTION** Proceed 5.35 mi west along the Canyon-Norris highway from the junction in Canyon Village. Bench mark is in the top of a 2 by 3 ft boulder that projects 24-inches above the ground surface, and 30.3 m (99.4 ft) south of the centerline of the highway. There is a small graveled pullout on S side of road at 5.4 mi, and a utility line running parallel to the highway on the south side. The bench mark is about 20 m west of a utility pole, and the boulder into which the bench mark is set is right along utility line trend, about 1 m below the level of the road.
