**DESCRIPTION** To reach station from the junction in West Yellowstone where the museum is located, go west on Yellowstone Ave for 0.7 mi to a T-junction at Iris Street. Turn left and go 0.05 mi to a gravel road at right. Turn right and go 0.85 mi, passing mark “B144” at 0.4 mi, to a fork. Take the right fork for 0.05 mi, when it merges with another major gravel road. Follow this road west for 0.6 mi (passing under power lines at 0.5 mi and a gravel road leading north at 0.55 mi) to a fork with a small road splitting left through a tall wooden fence. Take this road, and after passing through the fence the road curves right and a track splits left up an embankment. Take the track and park on the top of the embankment. Walk south across a ditch to a track road running east-west (only about 10 m from the specified parking location). Walk about 30 m east to the mark, metal witness post, and orange witness post in PVC pipe.
