DATE OF DESCRIPTION 2008

DESCRIPTION Proceed 10.1 km (6.30 mi) south along the Madison-West Thumb highway from Madison Junction, thence 3.5 km (2.15 mi) east along a service road and Mary Mountain Trail to a foot bridge across Nez Perce Creek, thence 12.7 km (7.9 mi) east along Mary Mountain Trail. Bench mark is cemented in a drill hole in the top of a large exposed area of a rock ledge about 8 x 15 feet along its east edge, on a prominent point between two small draws, 25.0 m (92.0 ft) west of the trail, and 20.0 m above the trail.

In 2008 the bench mark was searched for and not found. The rock ledge referenced in the NGS description was located, but the bench mark was not found. A scraping tool would be helpful to locate the bench mark, which probably exists but is buried under dirt or pine needles.
