DATE OF DESCRIPTION 2008

DESCRIPTION Proceed 10.1 km (6.30 mi) south along the Madison-West Thumb highway from Madison Junction, thence 3.5 km (2.15 mi) east along a service road and Mary Mountain Trail to a foot bridge across Nez Perce Creek, thence 13.6 km (8.45 mi) east along Mary Mountain Trail. Bench mark is cemented in a drill hole in an exposed area of rock outcrop, 68.0 m (223.1 ft) north of the north edge of Mary Lake, 415 m (136.2 ft) north-northeast of the northeast corner of the Mary Lake patrol cabin, 13.7 m (44.9 ft) north of the trail center, and 2.6 m above the trail.

In 2008 the bench mark was searched for and not found. The NGS description doesn't match the cabin location or terrain; however, the cabin bears the inscription "YCC 7-84," and therefore might have been moved since the description was written. This bench mark probably exists but will require a wide-ranging search.
