DESCRIPTION Proceed 10.1 km (6.30 mi) south along the Madison-West Thumb highway from Madison Junction, thence 3.5 km (2.15 mi) east along a service road and Mary Mountain Trail to a foot bridge across Nez Perce Creek, thence 9.2 km (5.70 mi) east along Mary Mountain Trail. Bench mark is cemented in a drill hole in the top of a large embedded boulder which projects 2.5 feet, 35.0 m (114.8 ft) east of the east edge of a large open meadow and swamp area, 30.0 m (98.4 ft) west of the west edge of a small open area, 17.5 m (57.4 ft) south of the center of the old trail (which is about 20 feet lower than the new trail due to numerous fallen trees), and 1.5 m below the old trail.
